## UFO sightings

I WAS interested to read about the UFO spotted by Hugh Merrick and Bob McCaig (Herald Express — February 24) as this is one sighting I can vouch for myself.

I followed this UFO through binoculars for about two minutes on the evening of Tuesday, February 17, at 7.20pm. It was flying in an easterly direction over Teignmouth.

Although my description of the object is fairly similar to that reported, I saw far fewer lights and am quite prepared to accept that it was a low flying aircraft (it certainly sounded like one), albeit unusually well lit.

What it certainly wasn't was a spacecraft from another world — such a discovery would probably be the most important event of the 20th century.

Although there have been literally thousands of UFO sightings since the 1939-45 War, not one of them has turned out to be an alien spacecraft. Such things can safely be consigned to the world of science fiction along with green Martians and plans to turn base metal into gold.
