

Special courier briefs world leaders in secret!

Five space aliens have been hospitalized for the treatment of burns covering up to 90 percent of their bodies following a fiery UFO crash in central China, a UFO research group reports.

Jacques Pretet, president of the Paris-based Citizens for Truth in UFO Reporting, said documents obtained from military sources behind the Bamboo Curtain called the survival of the aliens a priority but offered no prognosis.

Chillingly, the medical effort has reportedly been condemned by high-level Soviet and American officials, who believe the creatures are dangerous and should be killed or allowed to die.

"The survival or deaths of these five aliens has truly become a global concern," said Pretet. "Mikhail Gorbachev, Ronald Reagan and the militaries in both of their countries have taken an intense personal interest.

"I have it on authority that envoys of the Soviet Union, U.S. and at least five other countries will meet with the Chinese in Geneva to discuss the situation. The meeting will take place within the next four weeks."

In a preliminary agreement hammered out in Peking, Chinese doctors have

agreed to keep the superpowers briefed on the aliens' medical progress on a weekly basis, said Pretet.

According to the documents, the information is considered so sensitive that it will be conveyed via military couriers to prevent telephone wiretaps and satellite-signal intercepts, the UFO expert

said. If the description of the aliens in the Chinese documents is accurate, the creatures are indistinguishable to nine others who were pulled from the wreckage of a starship in the Soviet Union in 1985, said Pretet.

A classified report smuggled into Yugoslavia at the time said the aliens looked

like human children with three shocking exceptions — they appeared to be sexless, were covered with microscopic, flesh-colored scales and had no mouths.

The fate of those injured aliens remains a mystery, although Pretet believes the Soviets kept them alive long enough to conduct studies,

then exterminated them and preserved them on ice.

The Soviets refused then and now to discuss the incident.

And the Chinese, Soviets and Americans are apparently working together to suppress information about the Chinese crash, Pretet told reporters.
