Book recalls Loxley chiller

A PEACEFUL evening in Myers Lane, Loxley . . . then suddenly, over the brow of a hill, a couple in a car see a cloud of light with a figure in it.

The terrified pair say they sped off, chased down the road by the apparition. The incident is one of a number

written about in a book being published next week. *Strange Sheffield* is by Rob Wilson and David Clarke, who is South Yorkshire Investigator for the British UFO Research Association.

"I tried a reconstruction, but the Myers Lane sighting in the late Seventies remains a
