

No probe on UFO jet drama

AN INCIDENT involving a UFO and a jumbo jet is not to be investigated, British Airways confirmed yesterday.

The no-probe decision follows a report that a BA airliner was forced by a UFO to take diversionary action over Russia.

The incident, described in a letter to The Times by the flight's first officer, Anthony Colin, happened as the BA jumbo flew from Heathrow to Bangkok two months ago.

All five crew members, described in The Times as "seasoned, sceptical professionals", were baffled by the UFO with twinkling lights.

Mr Colin, crew spokesman, wrote: "It was definitely not an aircraft. None of us had ever seen anything like it before."

Russian air traffic control reported no other aircraft in the area at the time.
