of Britain has regularly featured in matters of the "unexplained."

And now the land which was the setting for the opening, horrific sequences in the cult film *An American Werewolf in London* is to be featured in a new book about paranormal events in the North of England.

UFO investigator Andy Roberts and writer David Clarke are col-

laborating on an ambitious research project to gather information on peculiar happenings on the Pennines.

They need reports of ghosts, "spooklights," alien craft, fairies, poltergeists, mystery animals — in fact, anything which cannot be easily explained.

And the results of their work will be published as an account of the mysteries of the Pennines.
