

# ARE THESE UFOs?

Photography enthusiast Mr. Alan Birch (76), of Willow Lane, Conisbrough, was baffled at the appearance of unidentified objects when he developed pictures he had taken of the night sky.

Mr. Birch, a member of Conisbrough Photography Club, took photos from the top of St. Peter's Church, Conisbrough, whilst on a night study with other members of the club. One other member, Ms. A. Houlbrook, of Cliff Villas, Conisbrough, also collected the image on three of her photographs. She said:

"This has really had me wondering. I feel certain that these objects are indeed U.F.O.s."

Further evidence of strange happenings in the sky came very recently when Mr. Birch, was snapping pictures of the moon from outside his house. A large cir-

cular object appeared firstly to the right of the moon, then showed itself again in a photograph taken seconds later, on the left of the moon.

Mr. Birch, said: "I am a sceptical person as regards U.F.O.s, but in all my years of photography I have never seen anything like this."
