

CHARLOTTE, N.C. (AP) — The boomerang-shaped object as big as two football fields made no sound as it cruised over Alfred and Elizabeth Edwards of Hampstead, but Mrs. Edwards says it gave her "the most terrifying feeling I've ever had in

my life. "It felt like my body was vibrating, but I think it was from fright," she said of the experience Jan. 9, 1986. "It scared me so bad I cried. It left me with a very uneasy feeling, a very humble feeling.

The experience was one of eight apparent UFO sightings reported in North Carolina in 1986 to Lincolnton resident George Fawcett, assistant state director for the Mutual UFO Network.
