On June 24th 1947 an American pilot witnessed a group of strange objects in the sky. He described them as moving 'like saucers skipping across the water'. From this report an anonymous journalist invented the term 'flying saucer', later to be adapted by Captain Ed Ruppelt, the USAF intelligence officer responsible for such matters to the more familiar 'U.F.O.' (Unidentified Flying Object).

In the four decades since, the UFO mystery has gone through many phases and now for the first time, accumulated evidence and major revelations can be made available to the public in one volume.
