

'Ello, 'ello . . that's a UFO

A UFO has been spotted in the night skies over London . . . and that's official, according to Scotland Yard today.

A total of eight startled police officers watched the grey-green, pink and electric blue object as it span, banked and hovered above Kensington.

A Yard spokesman said: "Police officers saw an unidentified object after a call from a members of the public. We are unable to say what it was."

The bizarre incident, which has been reported as a UFO in the station log at Kensington, took place shortly after midnight on Saturday

She called in the local law to verify her sighting. The first sceptical P-c to arrive was astounded to see a saucer-shaped object, dazzling in colour.

He asked for assistance and a further two officers arrived. They in turn called back to the station and five more came along.

They spent thirty minutes watching the UFO through the telescope and a pair of binoculars.
