Probe on Belmont UFO

UFO investigators are probing reports of a strange bright light over the moors at Belmont.

The light was spotted by Mrs Dorothy Lomax while she was washing the dishes at her Dunscur home.

Mrs Lomax said: "It was about 5pm. It was a

bright white light with a green haze around the edges. I looked through binoculars but all I could see was a haze.

"It was definitely something strange. It just hung above the moors for three quarters of an hour. I did not see it move at all then all of a sudden it van-

ished."

UFO expert Steve Bolan is to investigate Mrs Lomax's Belmont sighting. He said that UFOs are normally sighted over isolated areas like moors. He said: "They seem to know where to go. They are seen in less populated areas."
