

MYSTERY OF STRANGE OBJECTS IN SKY

Strange objects in the sky have baffled a former security officer who lives at Goldthorpe.

Mr. John Anders, of Goldthorpe Road, spotted a triangular shaped object with nine lights, eight orange and one white, jetting silently across the sky about 7a.m. on New Year's Eve.

He said: "I had just taken the dog out into the garden when the lights caught my eye. I'm not a believer in UFOs but this mystified me because there was no sound at all, and I watched it move across the sky to the

west, disappear, then come in to view again from the south east".

Mr. Anders (57), who is married with seven children, has never seen anything odd in the sky before, and feels there must be a rational explanation.

"The object was definitely of a triangular shape and was so clear that somebody else must have seen it", he said. If anyone did notice anything unusual in the sky that morning, or can offer any explanation for what Mr. Anders saw, he would like them to contact him on Roth. 895209.
