Heavens Above — EVEN THE STARS HAVE SEEN UFOs

WHAT DO the late Beatle John Lennon, former President Jimmy Carter, Muhammad Ali and Sammy Davis Jr. have in common? They've all seen UFOs.

John Lennon was so impressed with his sighting, he later referred to it in the song, *Nobody Told Me*.

"It definitely wasn't an aircraft. It was a UFO," he told friend Elliot Mintz.

Jimmy Carter was sitting on his veranda entertaining about 20 people while he was governor of Georgia in 1973 when a UFO with red and green flashing lights streaked across the night sky.

"It looked as big as the moon and changed colour several times from red to green," the former president says.

When he became president, Carter launched a £10 million study into UFOs.

Boxing great Ali says he once spotted "strange, bright lights that took off across the sky and disappeared."

And Sammy Davis says he doesn't know why UFO sightings are dismissed because they're often

reported by reputable people.

"I've seen them myself," says the stage and screen star.

His first sighting occurred more than 20 years ago while he was driving with his father after a nightclub engagement in Miami, Florida.

He spotted four strange objects over the ocean about 75 feet long with "a glowing bluish colour."

The objects later "shot away at incredible speed," he says.
