MYSTERIOUS MEN IN BLACK TERRIFY FLYING SAUCER WITNESSES

KEY UFO witnesses in America are being threatened by mysterious Men In Black — and warned not to reveal the secrets they've learned about space aliens.

Since the first UFO sightings there 40 years ago, frightened eye-witnesses have reported many eerie visits.

And Robert Richardson, of Toledo, Ohio, was visited three days after finding a lump of metal he believed came from a UFO. The Men In Black confronted him after he sent the metal to a UFO investigation group.

Dottie Andrews, 29, a housewife and mother, of North Carolina, and George Harrison, 43, of Kingman, Arizona, were also confronted by the Men In Black after sighting cigar-shaped UFOs in 1973.

Andrews was met by one of the mysterious men while at home.

"The spookiest thing was he asked questions I had already answered," said Dottie.

Harrison was confronted by three Men In Black at a filling station where he was having his car serviced.

"They stuttered a lot," he said. "One said they had come from far away. They regretted they couldn't stay for more than a few minutes, but said there were good reasons.

"I didn't get it. They said the right time hadn't come to tell others about flying saucers."
