Scientific investigators in Europe have uncovered irrefutable evidence proving beyond a doubt that space aliens have been visiting Earth for decades!

parent, globe-shaped headpiece. There were grids at the side of their heads, but bulged to show that they had ears."

Kembery said he gave the aliens cheese and crackers which they took with them when they left, and some whiskey.

In return, the space travelers gave him some "diamonds," which later turned out to be crystals, and some seeds which, when Kembery planted them, yielded "caramel-flavored berries," never seen before on Earth.

Kembery said the aliens left in their spaceship but made six return visits over the next two months. "I reported the visitations to

the police and I got a lot of ridicule for it. Some people thought I should commit myself to an asylum. But I know what I saw. It was marvelous."

Kembery has stuck to his bizarre tale for 20 years and it has held up under all attempts to prove it a hoax. Still, there are those who laugh off his close encounter as just so much hogwash.
