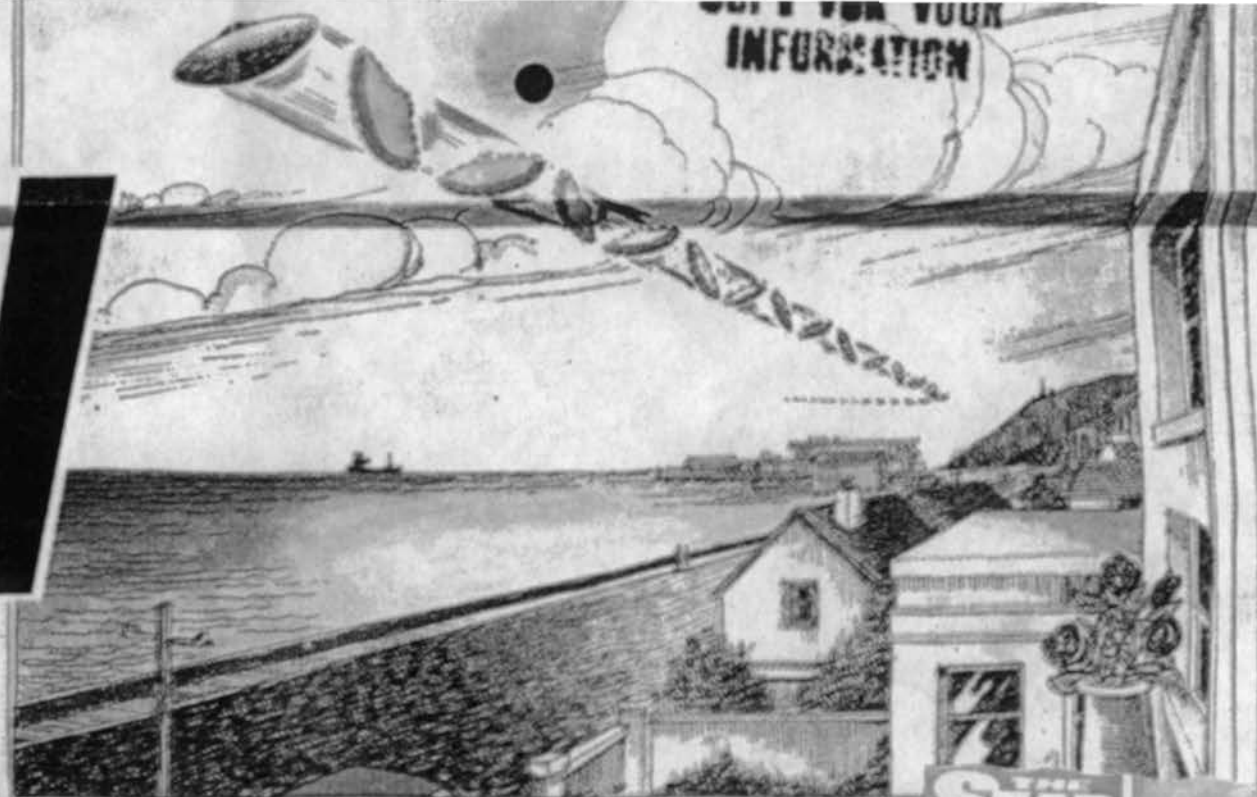


WE SAW UFOs

Terry said: "I saw a spaceship from a window in Dun Laoghaire.

"It was travelling north along the coast at a speed of 150 m.p.h."

He drew the sketch immediately after he saw the objects.

"I had it in my vision for about 12 seconds. Even now I can still see it clearly in my mind's eye," he said.

"After my experience I definitely believe in UFOs."

Terry said the spaceship he saw was grey on top and blackish-brown underneath.
