FIERY DISPLAY SEEN IN SKY — Indiana State Police received numerous calls from throughout the state Sunday night about a fireball in the sky. Police think it may have been a meteor.

State Police at the Putnamville post said troopers spent several hours searching for what was at first believed to be a downed airplane after receiving reports of bright lights in the sky about 9 p.m.

One Fountain County man described it as a bluish green light.

Sheriff's deputies in Grant and Huntington counties also reported sightings.

State police said the bright lights were seen all across Indiana and into Ohio.

On Saturday, scores of people in Tennessee, Kentucky and Indiana reported sighting what may have been a meteor that created a spectacular light show and shook the earth as it streaked through the atmosphere.
