

UFO CONFERENCE A CROWD PULLER

A conference on UFOs held in Rotherham over the weekend attracted hundreds of enthusiasts and interested locals.

"It all went very well and was a tremendous success," said conference organiser Mick Hanson, who was one of the main speakers at the conference, entitled "Above Top Secret".

He added: "We held the conference in the Assembly Rooms and the place was packed out: there was a high level of interest, with

well over four hundred people attending."

Because the conference was such a success, members of the Yorkshire UFO Society and Quest Magazine, who jointly organised the conference, are planning a bigger two day event for Rotherham next year.

Those who attended heard from a number of prominent speakers, including author Timothy Good, whose recent book "Above Top Secret" alleges a cover up of UFO information by officialdom.

There was also a

public showing of UFO evidence, including photos and slides of recent sightings over Rotherham and 26 year old Mick Hanson of Herringthorpe reported on the results of investigations in the local area. "Over 80 sightings of UFOs in South Yorkshire were received during the first six weeks of this year," he said. He added: "I'd like to thank everyone who turned up on Saturday."
