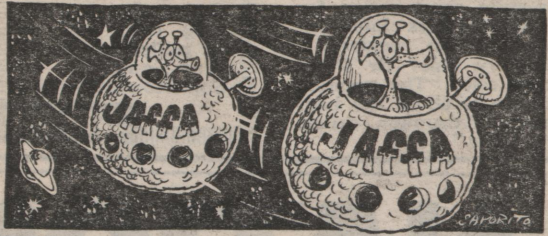


PEELED FOR FLYING JAFFAS



ET oranges pip experts

UFO hunters yesterday urged people to keep their eyes peeled—for flying ORANGES as big as houses!

Dozens of terrified witnesses have already reported the giant Jaffas, which are said to hum and glow bright orange. But all attempts to photograph the aliens have been fruitless.

The UFO Investigation Society's national co-ordinator, Dennis Harriman, warned: "People who look at these objects complain of mild sunburn.

"Policemen have privately admitted seeing them, but are frightened to report it."

Mystery of UF . . . Oranges!

A FLEET OF giant flying oranges is being probed by UFO experts.

They're the size of a house and leave people who spot them with a dose of sunburn.

They glow bright orange and have been sighted throughout the Midlands in recent weeks, according to Dennis Harriman, co-ordinator for the UFO Investigation Society.

Checks

He has received reports of the strange shapes being seen as far afield as Nottingham and Lichfield, Staffs.

People have claimed the giant jaffa lookalikes hover just above the ground.

And a 35-year-old woman from Beeston, Notts, reported: "I was totally amazed. My husband didn't believe me, but I'm not given to hallucinations."

Checks with the RAF and the Ministry of Defence have failed to link the weird sightings with aircraft.

Mr. Harriman said: "I am not saying they are from another planet but you cannot rule out the possibility."

A FLEET of giant ORANGES has been sighted flying over the Midlands.

Witnesses claim the oversize Outspans give off an orange glow that has left some people with sunburn.

A woman from Beeston, Nottingham, said the oranges were about the size of a house. They hovered just above the ground and gave off a humming noise.
