

# GEE WHIZ: FLYING ORANGES

UNIDENTIFIED flying objects whizzing over the skies of Harlow caused a stir on Thursday.

The bright orange balls were first spotted by an STC accountant, Bill Johnson, when he paid a visit to the bathroom at 1.30am.

"I saw something through the frosted glass window and at first thought there was a car on fire in the street outside," said Bill, who lives in Tanys Dell.

"The curtains seemed to be ablaze with fire and flames appeared to be flickering up the window."

Bill, a grandfather, said: "When I told the family, they said dad's losing his marbles."

But Bill's discovery was substantiated when he read a report in a national paper about flying oranges seen in the sky over the Midlands that night.

Two of his neighbours also saw something strange.

"I don't think there are any little Martians sitting up there, but there are some things we can't explain," he told the Star.

A spokesman from the Ministry of Defence commented: "Our sole interest in UFOs is if they have a military connotation. You do see some peculiar things in the sky."
