

Frank spots UFOs on a city fly-past

WHILE the good citizens of Winchester were asleep in their beds last week creatures from outer space were flying overhead in yellow flying saucers.

"There they were flying over and there was a hissing sound," says UFO enthusiast Frank Barnes.

Frank (59) of Vale Road, Highcliffe claims to have seen the two UFOs flying over the Broadway towards Eastleigh at about 6.30am on Thursday, while out delivering papers.

"They were about the size of two houses and going quite slowly, about 50mph I should think," he added.

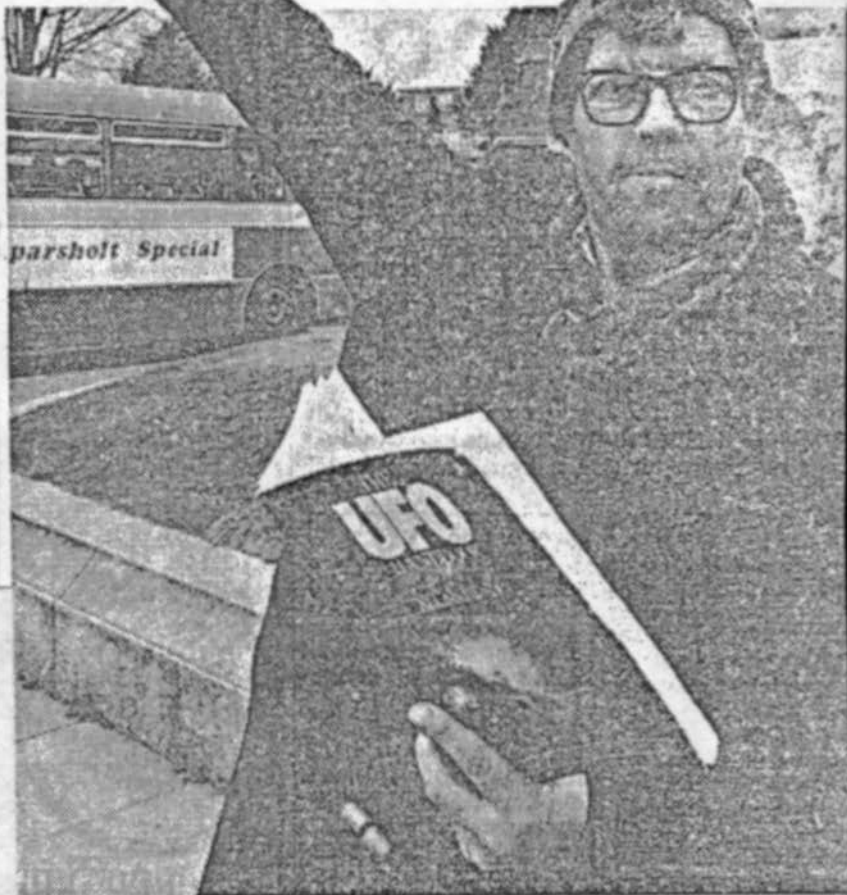
And he claims others witnessed the extraterrestrial phenomenon—including two policemen out on patrol.

But a mystified police spokesman said nothing had been reported to him.

Frank, a member of the Romsey UFO Research Society, said he was surprised to see them so early in the year.

"They generally appear round about June or July."

He claimed the mystery rings of flattened corn which appeared last August at Cheesefoot Head were caused by a giant grey 'spaceship-like' object, which he saw while walking his dog.
