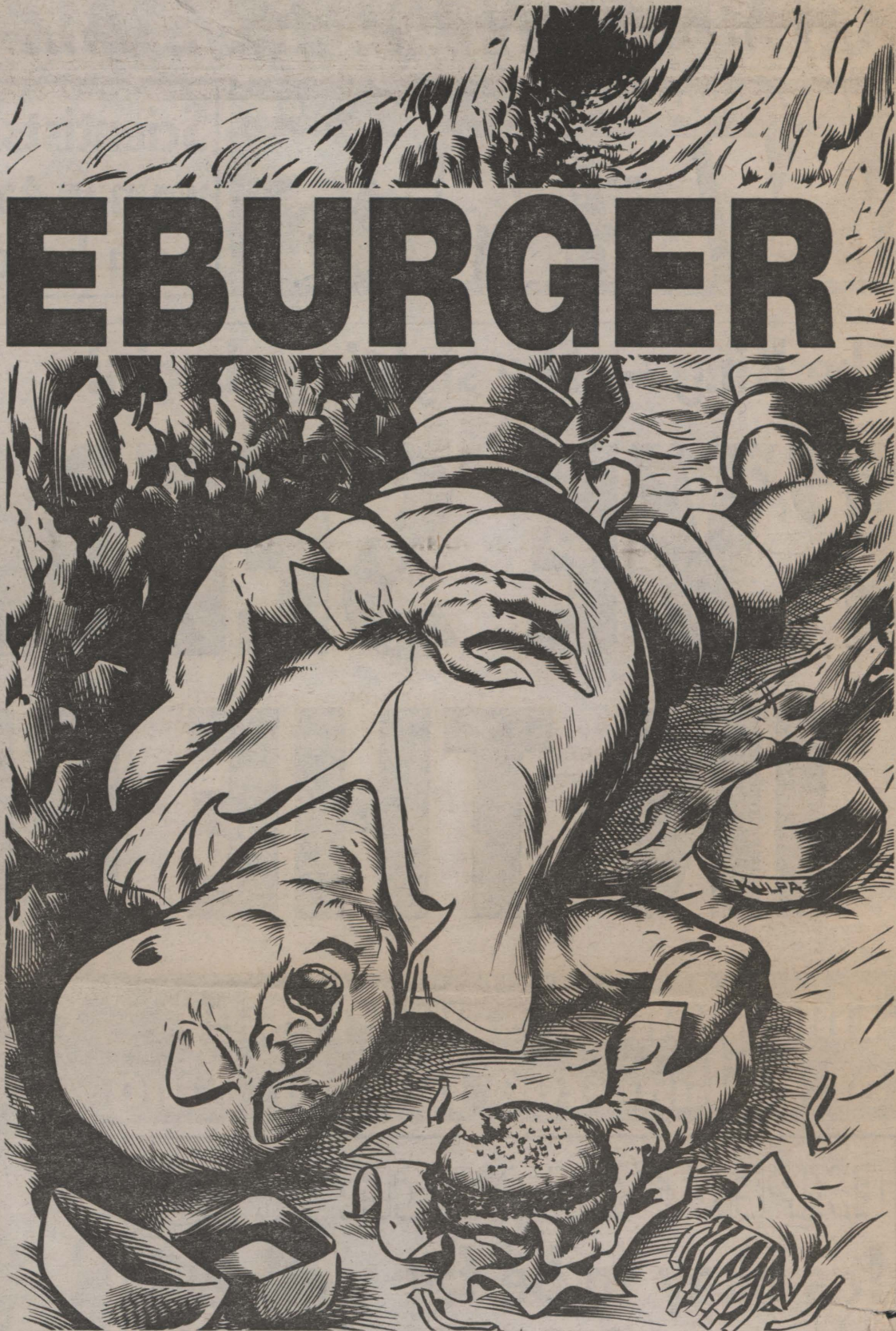


BURP!

CHEESEBURGER KILLS SPACE ALIEN!
