They were bald, with massive liquid-like slitty eyes, yellowish-brown skin that felt like leather, two holes for nostrils and big, floppy lips.

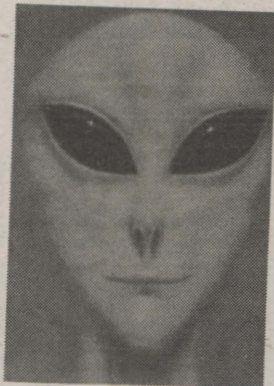
And to prove his chilling time with the beings actually took place, he agreed to take a lie detector test — and PASSED.
