

# Secret service link as UFO mystery deepens

A TOP ufologist has pointed a questioning finger at the government after a mystery man stole camera film containing pictures of a UFO from a Chandler's Ford woman.

The theory that the man was an agent with government connections is the latest bizarre explanation for the disappearance of the film which records a glowing white and yellow object in the skies above Chandler's Ford.

Mrs Margaret Wilson spotted the weird object as she drove her car back from Bournemouth last week. Police told the press and a man claiming to be a reporter offered to develop the film and return the pictures.

No-one has been able to trace him since.

The latest theory was put forward by Manchester solicitor Harry Harris, appointed by Mrs Wilson to find the man.

He is described as about five feet eight inches tall, with collar length dark hair, green eyes, and wearing jeans and a white shirt. He had a tape measure fastened to his right hip and drove an old dark red car.

Mr Harris's suspicions were roused because the picture had not appeared in any of the local newspapers or agencies.

"I believe he is either an unscrupulous ufologist prepared to poach anything, or a member of some secret organisation, possibly with government connections," he said.

"I appeal for this man to return the film to Mrs Wilson, it is her property and retaining it is theft."
