## Mystery pilot who buzzes Paris 'could be computer'

A PHANTOM plane that is buzzing Paris could be a robot, it was claimed yesterday.

Every night, 250 police with infra-red binoculars watch for the plane which has made at least five sorties over the city.

All-night helicopter patrols stand-by to give chase if the mystery pilot is spotted.

But yesterday one of France's leading stunt

aviators, Jean Selice, said that a white light on the plane suggests it is computer-programmed or controlled from a rooftop.

It could even be a kit that can land on a road or field and be folded up and hidden before it can be traced.

The Government, embarrassed at not being able to trace the plane, are spending millions of pounds to solve the mystery.
