

ALIEN BABY FOUND IN JUNGLE

**Space-age tot
living with
family of apes**



A TARZAN space baby has been found deep in the Amazon jungle — raised by gorillas as a chest-thumping Lord of the Apes.

The alien tot with pointy Mr Spock ears has been hailed as Tarzan 2001 by boffins who found it in the arms of mother monkeys.

With a single nostril in the middle of its button nose and spooky mirror eyes, it is believed a careless alien mum let it fall out of a UFO pram.

But space-watchers have warned it could be the first of an alien invasion force reared to conquer Earth like Tarzan tamed the jungle.

"This is the scientific find of the century," Dr Burton Spiller told natives in the Amazon basin village of Anori, according to reporters.

"The child is living proof that intelligent life exists somewhere other than Earth.

"For reasons we don't understand someone has delivered him to us — although

it could have literally fallen to Earth."

Monkey

Believed to be just 16 months old, the space baby was found by a group of anthropologists who at first thought it was a retarded human child.

Surrounded by a family of gorillas, the tot squarked in an alien version of ape language and grubbed on the ground like a monkey.

But having saved the space child from its monkey minders the scientists became convinced it was of a much higher intelligence.

"The child is strong for his age," said Dr Spiller —

confirming fears the baby was being brought up as Lord of the Apes by the muscle-bound gorillas.

"The baby is under observation around the clock by scientists and we are learning more about him every day," added the Swiss scientist.

"He speaks fluently, but in a language that we have not

yet been able to understand.

"We are most interested in his eyes. Sometimes, they become mirror-like — you can actually see your face in them."

Conquerors

Meanwhile, local UFO-watchers have given out a warning that the Tarzan alien

might be a spy for an invading army.

"Dr Spiller talks about the baby as if it were a gift to humanity from another world, but it could as easily be a SCOURGE," said Amazonian UFO researcher, Tajano de Morais.

Foolish

"I think it's foolish to take a chance. He might even be a spy among us or a scout for a race of alien conquerors," he added.

But keeping the extraordinary tot under wraps in a secret jungle hideaway, Dr Spiller said the alien must be considered friendly until proved otherwise.
