SPACE BABY

A Swiss scientist claims to have found an extra-terrestrial baby that was abandoned in the Brazilian jungle!

Dr. Burton Spiller said the tot appears to be 14 to 16 months old and is in surprisingly good health.

The boy bears some resemblance to a human baby.

But his pointed ears, colorless eyes and tube-like nose strongly suggest that his parents and ancestors did not come from this planet.

"This is the scientific find of the century," Dr. Spiller told reporters in the Amazon River city of Anori.

"This child is living proof that intelligent life exists somewhere other than Earth. "For reasons we may not

ever understand someone has delivered him to us."

Dr. Spiller says he found the baby in a jungle clearing on July 14.

The anthropologist originally thought the strange-looking baby might be deformed or retarded.

But once the child recovered from hunger and exposure it became clear that he was the healthy offspring of a non-human being.

Dr. Spiller refused to say where the baby has been taken.

But a close associate told reporters that the child is being studied in a military facility south of Anori.

American officials were also close-mouthed.

They refused to comment on reports that they are working with the child. But Washington sources more or less confirmed it by saying

that Brazilian and American scientists "have always cooperated in scientific research and will continue to do so in the future."

Dr. Spiller added: "The child does not appear to possess any special powers but he is quite strong for his age."

"Of course, he is under observation by scientists around the clock. And we are learning more about him every day. He also speaks fluently — but in a

language that we have not yet been able to understand.

"We are most interested in his eyes. Sometimes they become mirror-like — you can actually see your face in them."

Trajano A. de Moraes, the Brazilian UFO researcher, has called for a multinational investigation and full disclosure to the public.

"I am as excited about the alien as anybody but I don't

think we scientists should look at things through rose-colored glasses," he said. "Dr. Spiller talks about the baby as if it were positively a gift from

another world to humanity. "But it could just as easily be a scourge. And if that's

the case, mankind must know before it's too late.

"What if this child does possess an intelligence or power that makes him su-

Anthropologist Spiller discounted the critic's fears. He said the extraterrestrial baby

must be considered friendly "until he does something to prove otherwise."
