Mystery UFO snapped

This Unidentified Flying Object was photographed over Kidderminster last weekend by local man Roland Bowen.

The sixty-seven-year-old retired carpet worker was relaxing in his Windermere House flat in Hurcott Road at 6 pm on Sunday, September 18 when he saw a glittering, golden, rotating, egg-shaped object cruising gracefully across the clear blue sky.

A keen amateur photographer, Roland grabbed his camera and took some rapid photographs of the object which he estimated to be around a quarter of a mile to the north, travelling west to east, around 300 feet off the ground and about the size of a house.

He took the undeveloped film straight from his camera and handed it over to a Kidderminster Shuttle/Times and News reporter.
