Humming black over town sparks UFO skywatch plan

A MASS skywatch may be held in Southend following an unprecedented number of calls about unidentified objects.

The East Anglian branch of the British Unidentified Flying Objects Research Association had another 26

calls over the weekend after their hot line number was published at the end of an Echo feature about them.

Now spokesman Ron West said he is considering a mass sky watch.

From 8 pm to midnight on Saturday there were 26 calls to BUFORA from the Southend and Basildon area about

lights and at 1.25 am on Sunday three people said they had been watching a hovering light over Southend.

At 2.50 am there was another call from watchers in Rayleigh to say they had seen a hovering light.

At 3.30 am six people said they had watched and heard a black cigar

shaped object which was humming.

They watched it for 10 minutes before it disappeared towards London.

At 4 am two people said they had been watching an object that had been making a swishing noise.

At 4.30 am others saw a blue light hovering over Southend.
