

POLITICAL LID KEPT ON THOSE UFOs

EVEN if the Government knew anything about Unidentified Flying Objects, it wouldn't tell, a UFO enthusiast declared last night.

UFO buff Keith Polley told The Journal: "Official bodies never

give out information on anything like that."

Keith — a member of WATSUP (Wessex Association for the Study of Unexplained Phenomena) — added: "Groups like ours are considered a nuisance, they won't tell us anything."

Anyway, according to Keith, a 45-year old photographic technician, 99.9 percent of so-called

UFO sightings can be easily explained.

"More often than not people get mixed up. Strange lights in the sky are usually aircraft, or distant pylons.

Studying

"After more than ten years of studying the unexplained, I have yet to

see a unidentified flying object which I believe to be really unexplainable.

"I'm quite disappointed, really, when you look into the subject you'll find there's not really much happening."

WATSUP which has members throughout the South, monitors a range of subjects which are unexplained, including ghosts and UFOs.
