# More strange sky sightings

ANOTHER batch of UFO sightings over Chelmsford have been reported by flying object investigators East Anglian UFO.

They are the latest in a line of sightings by witnesses since the end of January.

The inverted triangle of lights seen in the area on January 28 and 29 were spotted again on February 17 at Springfield between 8.30 and 9pm.

And a large, glowing orange ball was witnessed over the county town at 11.30pm on February 15.

UFO investigator Ron West commented: "There must have been lots of people who saw that one."

But the strangest sighting was the 12" metallic disk followed by a Chelmsford man driving towards his home town on February 20.

The man was 75 yards behind the car in front of him when the disk appeared as he drove along the A12 from Brentwood.

It followed the car at a height of three foot before vanishing after ten minutes. 1

White glowing balls were seen heading towards Chelmsford at 8.45pm on Monday.
