Two more say: We spotted a sky mystery

THE LATEST in a spate of UFO sightings was reported last week by two Austin Rover workers, Howard Carey and Roy Townsend.

They both saw a round brightly lit object travelling northwards over Swindon.

Mr Carey, who lives in Dores Road, Upper Stratton, said: "I have never before seen anything that could not have been explained.

"At first I thought it was a Hercules but there was no noise. It was bathed in a whitish glow and had a very irregular shape.

"There was an intense blue light at the front which pulsed.

"It veered to the right and to the left and then headed off towards Cirencester at a faster speed."

Fellow worker Roy Townsend, of Alfred Street, Swindon, said: "I just don't know what it was. It had a ring of lights and it was glowing."
