# UFO enthusiasts 2374 meet at library

UFO enthusiasts from all over Britain will be hoping to prove that 'we are not alone' at a seminar at Central Library on Saturday.

Members of the Independent UFO Network (IUN) and the British UFO Research Association will be the joint hosts of a discussion on extra-terrestrial abductions which have allegedly occurred throughout the country.

David Barclay, of Stubbington Way, Shipley, editor of the magazine *The UFO Debate*, says the meeting will be of particular importance.

He says: "Hopefully, it will draw attention away from occurrences in the South of England, to the experiences of people in this part of the country."

David, who has believed in the existence of beings other than ourselves for the past 40 years or so, admits

that UFO enthusiasts have had some 'bad Press' recently, but says they are not all cranks.

David hopes the seminar will do much to dispel people's fears by providing a forum for debate on the subject.

Two speakers will be making a presentation at the seminar, both of which will be fully illustrated by photographs.

Andy Roberts, from Brighouse, will give a short introduction to abductions before concentrating on abductions in the north of England.

John Spencer, internationally renowned UFO researcher and author, will then concentrate on abductions world-wide.

David Barclay says "Everyone is welcome to the seminars - aliens and all!"
