Galactic visitor

A real-life unidentified flying object landed in a ball of fire on the shore south of Haifa after midnight on Thursday of last week and burned itself out.

Delighted UFO watcher Hadassah Arbel, who had long been waiting for palpable proof of her convictions, adjudged the object to have been a spy disc sent out by an alien spaceship to measure the electro-magnetic waves emanating from earth.

However, Professor Giora Shaviv, an astro-physicist from the Technion in Haifa, said if the object were not debris from a military exercise — which has been ruled out by the military — it was a piece of debris from an orbiting satellite or missile.
