Farmers on watch for stock mutilators

CODETTE, Sask. (CP) — Farmers near Codette are taking extra precautions to safeguard their animals after the mutilation of a bull last month.

"Those of us with cattle are babysitting them," said Janet Paisley, who farms with her husband Wayne near this community 100 km (60 miles) east of Prince Albert.

There has also been a rash of disappearances and mutilations of domestic pets, Paisley said.

The bull was killed July 19. The tongue and penis had been cut out.
