# SOVIETS BLAST FRIENDLY UFO OUT OF THE SKY!

## *Outraged experts fear retaliatory attack!*

The Soviet Union incinerated an alien starship with a surface-to-air missile in an attack that has been characterized as mindless aggression — and possibly even an act of war!

Dr. Marcel Cavaleri said the Soviets launched the missile from a silo in Siberia and destroyed the starship while it orbited Earth on June 21.

The Russian government angrily denies the allegation. But Dr. Cavaleri quotes highly-placed NATO sources as having confirmed the missile launch — and destruction of the saucer-shaped starship in space.

"The Soviet Union must be tried in the court of world opinion for this mindless act of aggression and war," the Swiss physicist declared at a news conference in Geneva.

"There was absolutely no evidence that the starship was anything but friendly. It had been monitored for days at tracking stations all over the planet without incident.

"It is unbelievable that the Sovi-

ets would take it upon themselves to attack. The whole world could be held to blame for the aggression.

"Should the extraterrestrials who sent the starship to Earth decide to avenge the attack, every nation and person on this planet will be in peril."

American intelligence sources refused to discuss the incident for the record but privately confirmed Dr. Cavaleri's report.

They said the Soviet missile was launched at 5:05 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time on Wednesday, June 21.

It hit and destroyed the alien star-

ship seven minutes later, at 5:12 a.m., the sources said.

"There was no attempt to establish radio contact with the starship — it was attacked without warning," said Dr. Cavaleri.

"If there were extraterrestrials aboard they never had a chance. The Soviet missile carried a nuclear payload so powerful it actually vaporized the craft."

UFO researchers around the world were outraged by the Soviet action and called on the Russians to acknowledge their mistake.

They also want to broadcast a radio apology into deep space in the hope that the extraterrestrial civilization that sent the starship to Earth will hear it and rule out a retaliatory attack.

"The seriousness of the Soviet action cannot be underestimated," Marcel Koller, president and founder of the Paris-based UFO research group Galaxy, said.
