Extra-terrestrial 2374 finds a home in the town hall

AN extra-terrestrial showpiece is to become a fixture at Ossett Town Hall following the soaraway success of the recent UFO conference.

The delighted organisers from the Yorkshire UFO Society have announced their intention

to make the conference an annual attraction after this year's event drew in people from across the country.

Visitors from as far afield as Reading, Berkshire and Liverpool attended the event which organisers promised would blow the lid off the UFO debate once and for all.

In all, more than 350 people arrived to hear revelations about the shooting down and capture of an alien spaceship in South Africa earlier this year.

And they squirmed in their seats as Timothy Good, author of the best-selling UFO book "Above Top Secret," showed slides

of alleged alien experimentation and surgery on animals.

"The response of the public has been tremendous and there would have been even more people but for traffic delays on the M1. I think the event has been a resounding success and Ossett is the ideal place for it."
