

# Police get rush of UFO claims

MELBOURNE.— Police spent yesterday investigating more than 50 reports of a UFO buzzing the foreshore of Port Phillip Bay.

Residents reported seeing a bright, long, cigar-shaped object with orange fireballs at both ends hovering 250m above the water and about 500m offshore.

Constable Jeremy Oliver of St Kilda police said the sightings, between 2.45am and 5am, had been linked to a patch of scorched grass which appeared yesterday at bayside Elwood.
