

Siberian UFO in 7,000 kph fly-past

HUNDREDS of people in Omsk, western Siberia, claimed to have observed an unidentified flying object last week, the newspaper Socialist Industry reported.

One of the eye-witnesses was Major Vladimir Loginov who pointed out that the object he saw was not picked up by his radar: "Therefore, I can only talk about my own visual observations.

"An object appeared several kilometres high in the sky. It looked like a large luminous ball and had four bright parallel spotlights shining from it."

Major Loginov claimed to have watched the UFO for five minutes before the lights went out and the air became turbulent as the ball moved swiftly eastwards.

"Our pilots from a nearby airfield also reported seeing the object, although it didn't show on their radar either.

"We passed our observations on to our colleagues in the Altai and they later reported a sighting too. We worked out that whatever we had seen had travelled at a speed of roughly 7,000kph.

"I wouldn't like to say what the object was exactly, but it certainly didn't appear to be an atmospheric phenomenon."
