Amid confusion over what had happened, the deputy commander of the Cambodian air force Kung Mony said he understood that a foreign plane had crashed in the Cambodian province of Kampot but later retracted the suggestion.

Villagers in Kampot said they had also heard a loud explosion and found small chunks of metal near the coast.

One possibility is that a military aircraft taking part in a secret mission exploded but its country of origin has not claimed it.

The theory was given some weight by the Vietnam News Agency (VNA) report which said: "The explosion happened at about 8 km above the ground, and perhaps it was a plane, but authorities could not identify whether it was a civil or military aircraft."
