"And that kept popping up in my head, the idea of not being on the guest list."

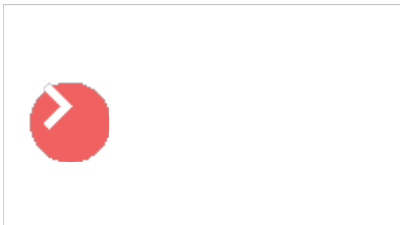

A short tour also follows but as Mr Martin told Clash magazine: "We don't want it to go on too long as some of the band start to go mental..."

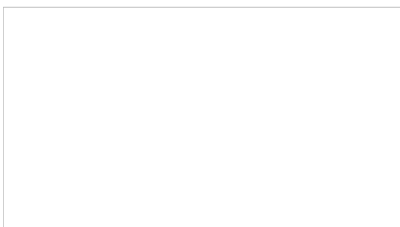
