

Pilot Tells Of Mystery Glow In The Sky

A SOUTH AFRICAN Airways Boeing commander, Captain R. B. Truter, has reported seeing an unidentified flying object between Las Palmas and Zurich.

"We were at 37,000ft. when we spotted the object, which appeared to be half an inch in diameter, had a bluish-white glow and was perfectly circular," says Truter.

"The co-pilot, navigator and I watched it for ten minutes, during which time it did not appear to change its position in relation to stars which were visible in the vicinity, or in relation to the aircraft."

Later the position and shape of the glow altered, and it disappeared just before the sun appeared above the horizon.
