

'Mystery Light' Seen After TV Stops Working

A second person has reported seeing a "mysterious light" Friday night minutes after his television set just as mysteriously stopped working.

Matthew Rybczyk of 106 Morse Rd., said that at just about 9:45 p. m. Friday he was at home watching TV when all of a sudden it stopped working.

He went outside, thinking the snow or wind had damaged the antenna, and upon opening the door saw the "mysterious light" in the sky.

Rybczyk said that as he saw the flash he also heard a humming sound. He reported the light was moving in the sky above the tree line to the east at a slow rate.

A Concord man Friday night had reported seeing a similar light while driving his car on Route 4A between Wilmot and Enfield.

This motorist, who remained anonymous, said that his car's radio went off as well as the lights, and the motor stopped. He added that after pulling up, he looked out and saw the light and heard a humming sound.

In both cases electrical power was restored when the "mysterious light" vanished.
