## BACK IN

## THE SKY

**T**HE "Thing" that has been haunting Warminster, Wilts, was seen again last night.

Following a meeting to bury rumours about the mysterious objects and sounds seen in the Wiltshire sky, about 90 people including a party of grammar schoolboys have been keeping an all-night vigil.

Said Christopher Robinson, 14-year-old Swindon grammar schoolboy and one of the "Thing from outer space" observers: "In a blinding flash of light it seemed to explode and divide into two brighter portions. Either that or the first simply vanished and was replaced by two others above."

Another Swindon grammar schoolboy, Graham Chalifour, said: "Other people must surely have seen them.

It made me tremble for a while.

"It was a wonderful and stirring spectacle. The last two objects kept changing their speed and altering course."

### SOUND

Norman Leighton, aged 14, also from the school, added: "These two zig-zagged to and fro, jerked up and down rapidly, then sped across the sky at an angle of 45 degrees, before disappearing."

His friend Christopher Crooks-Radford, also 14, said: "This last one was visible for a good minute or more. There was no sound and no sign of coloured landing lights so they were definitely not planes.

"They were not shooting stars either—I've seen plenty of those in the past."
