

Is there 'A Thing' in the sky?

THERE could be "A Thing" in the sky over Northolt.

Mr. David Marlowe, of Avonclose, Hayes, appealed, in a recent letter to the County Times, for news of an unusual light seen in the sky by friends of his in the Northolt area.

"The light is described as flame or orange, oval in shape, with a tendency to expand and contract but with little other movement", he says.

"It was last spotted on July 26, a Tuesday, in exactly the same position as it was seen in March of this year by another person living in the same road.

"I have good reason to believe that other people have seen this unusual light but are shy of admitting it", he said. "Even my friends were a bit diffident about it, but there is little doubt that they did see it and so did the other people I spoke to."

POSITION

Mr. Marlowe wants to find others who have seen this light in the sky from a different angle, as it may then be possible to locate its exact position by extending two lines and angles of vision and observing on a map where they cross.

Several people have already written to him, but not with the clues he is seeking.

"There may be a perfectly rational explanation for the whole thing, but I need more evidence before I can attempt to work on it at all," says Mr. Marlowe.
