

# Flying saucer 'seen'

FIFTY space watchers claimed yesterday that they saw a flying saucer hovering over a small country town at the weekend.

The 50, members of the International Sky Scouts, staged an all-night vigil at Warminster, Wilts.

They claim that seven times they saw a "long, cigar-type object" hovering over the town.

From a hilltop viewpoint they saw the object change colours from white to red, green to orange and back to white.

Keith Palmer, of Tottenham, London, who is secretary of the International Sky Scouts, said:

"Unidentified flying objects have been seen frequently over Warminster and we have decided to try and identify them positively by keeping long vigils.

"Unfortunately this time the rain hampered us but 50 of our members saw the saucer. They definitely exist and may be dangerous."

He added: "When we get positive proof on film we are going to demand an official Government investigation into the 'objects'."
