

Eyes UP for flying saucers

Ten thousand people in 21 countries will be craning their necks and studying the sky for flying saucers at exactly 3.0 p.m. on Saturday.

Britain's contribution will

be 120 members of the International Sky Scouts Association who will be assembling in Warminster, Wiltshire, that favourite spot for spotting unidentified flying objects.

"We'll have astro-compasses, UFO detectors, and cine cameras," said the "sky watch" organiser, Mr. Keith Palmer.

The sky watchers meet once a month. "But nor-

mally in London, where we just look up at the sky. Last time we went to Warminster we took pictures of 'things'—unfortunately they didn't come out very well," said Mr. Palmer.

The enthusiasts are hopeful they will see something on Saturday. "There have been three landings at Warminster in the last nine days, you know," said Mr. Palmer.
