

Mystery of 'flying saucer' 100 saw

TWO mysterious objects from the skies were yesterday frightening hundreds of people and giving experts a headache. Mystery No. 1 was at Clifton, Nottingham, where 100 people claimed to have seen a flying saucer landing.

The crowd of adults and children had gathered on high ground near Fairham Comprehensive School after a report swept the area about a flying saucer.

They all claimed to have seen a disc-shaped, silvery saucer about 30ft. long landing.

But police who went to investigate said that the saucer must have been an optical illusion.

Mystery No. 2 was down in the New Forest.
