

MYSTERY 'BOMB' HITS HOME

A mystery metal object fell from the sky and crashed on to the roof of a house in Bickley, Kent, today.

Cylinder shaped and about 9in. long, it hit the front of the home of Mr. John Boatwright in Homemead Road, and broke telephone wires.

Bromley police were called and placed the "mortar-bomb" shaped object into a bucket be-

fore taking it away for examination.

Stopped and glowed

Meanwhile new reports of unidentified flying objects came from the London area today:

Mr. Peter Embleton, of Yew Tree Close, Welling, said: "At 7.30 a.m. I spotted two bright

white lights, each about the size of a half-crown, as I was driving down Shooters Hill, Woolwich.

"As I watched they shot across the sky to the west, then stopped quite still and glowed before vanishing. I saw them altogether for about 20 seconds."

With him was Mr. Eddie Hodkin, of Elsa Road, Welling, who said: "The things we saw were definitely not planes."
