500 with eyes on the sky

MUNICH.

Ufologists of the world, meeting in the West German city of Mainz today, are to demand that the United Nations should set up an Inter-Continental Institute to establish contact with unidentified flying objects.

It is the 7th International World Congress of UFO researchers. Britons are among the 500-odd delegates.

The resolution adds ... by the Congress has been prepared by the head of the American delegation, Colman Von Kewiczky.

It calls on the United Nations and all earthly powers to establish an UFO Research Institute to be set up on international territory.

The institute, it says, should provide a landing place to receive visitors from outer space, whose safety must be internationally guaranteed.

Contact aim

The resolution added that the Institute should also undertake "to establish by every possible means physical contact with the representatives of extra-terrestrial powers and the occupants of space ships in order to set up official relations."

The congress lasts until Monday. Apart from talking, the delegates will spend a lot of time hopefully studying the skies above Mainz.
