

'Saucer' riddle of jet crash disaster

Did a flying saucer have anything to do with the Caravelle plane crash in Sussex in November?

This is the startling question which members of the Surrey investigation group on aerial phenomena are trying to answer.

For a sighting of a luminous oval-shaped object which hovered over trees at Cutmill, Surrey, 30 minutes before the crash, has just come to light.

It was seen by 20-year-old Michael Chadd, a plumber, of Park Barn Drive, Guildford, and his girl friend Linda. Cutmill is about 10 miles from the scene of the crash near Haslemere.

'SPACE SHIP'

Michael said: "The object was visible for about 15 minutes. It looked just like a space ship."

Mr. Omar Fowler, chairman of the Surrey UFO group, said: "If anyone in the vicinity of Cutmill or Haslemere on November 4 saw anything unusual in the sky, would they please contact us immediately at Guildford 63381."

The Iberian Airways Caravelle crashed into Blackdown Hill at Fernhurst, Sussex, killing 37 passengers and crew. Among the dead was June Thorburn, the actress.
